This guide is an explanation of how to download and register to use the **Airmid app**, which allows you do access your **Systmonline Patient Access** account quickly and easily through a mobile device. The app allows you to do a lot to manage your health care requirements.

This app is provided by the same company as the GP online services Systmonline Patient Access. The app enables you to access the same information as you do from your Systmonline account, but through your mobile device such as a smartphone or a tablet.

First, you need to download the App from the Google Play (if you have an Android device, e.g. Samsung) or the App Store (if you have an Apple device such as a iPhone or iPad). Search for "Airmid UK" to enable you to install it.





Once installed you will be able to open it by

tapping the **"OPEN"** button.

If you are already registered to use The Cranborne Practice online services, you do not need to register again. All you need to do is enter the same details (user name and password) as you do with your Systmonline account. If you don't already have a Systmonline account, please email The Cranborne Practice at

<u>cranborne.reception@dorsetgp.nhs.uk</u> with a photo or scan of your ID (preferably your driving licence as it shows your address) and then the Practice will email back the log in details.



Please note that some of the screens in this guide may look slightly different depending on the mobile device you use.

Once you know your login details, login is simple. Input your User Name here. . .

. . and your password here.

Then tap on the LOG IN box.

We are using dummy patient login details in this example here. You can check that you have entered your password details correctly by tapping the 💽 icon.

If you have an NHS login please note that you can use that to access the App, but this guide does <u>not</u> cover that process.



FaceID

Set up FaceID now to help keep your data secure and to speed up logging into Airmid UK.

You should only set up FaceID if you are the only user on this device.

Once you have entered your login details, depending on your device, you may be asked if you want to set up Face ID or fingerprint ID to speed up your login in the future.

Tap "**Yes**" or "**No**" depending on what you want to do.

Go to the Organisations screen to request access to services.

It should then bring you to a page which lists the services your account has been set up to access, book and manage GP appointments, request repeat prescriptions, view your medical records.
